1. Scenario #1: An appraisal is created/received and the Assessor physically deducts the amount for pollution control. Both amounts are then added into RealWare with their own abstract codes. In this case, both numbers that are entered are positive numbers. Note, this is currently the way the Department maintains the data in the tlkpabstcode table.
